WELCOME LETTER**

Welcome to Clean Break Flyball's Summer Sizzler Tournament! The tournament is being run as one (1) two-day unlimited tournament with 22 Regular teams, 6 Multi-breed teams, 26 Open Teams and 4 Veterans teams in 2 rings. 1st place through 3rd place division winners will receive placement awards . Please sign up any dogs who earn NAFA titles during the weekend (please, only those that are earned at our tournament) on our posted sheet. We will be giving title ribbons to each dog who earned them at our tournament. Thanks for all your entries and we look forward to some great racing! We are having two rings which will provide over 70 Ft. of runback. Racing will be from 30 to 42 heats for each team. You will find a seeding chart, format, and racing schedule for Saturday and Sunday, along with directions to the tournament site on our website at www.cleanbreakflyball.com. We will also have a sheet available on Saturday to sign-up Jr. Handlers. If anyone has any suggestions or complaints, please see any Clean Break members for assistance. The judges will be Scott Chamberlain and Geoff Brown with Carle Lee Dembeck as Relief judge.

Jim Geiser of Game Time Photography (www.seegametimephotos.com) will be our tournament photographer.

NAFA C-2 score sheets will be filled out with race schedules pre-printed. They will consist of one double sided sheet for each team. If you are using stickers, be sure to bring one for each side of the sheet. Please do not bring entire C-2 sheets unless your sheets have the races pre-printed.

Scoring:

All divisions will score 1 point per heat won + 4 points for winning the race, 2 points for a tied race, 1/2 point for tied heats and 0 for a loss.

Ties for tournament placement will be decided by:

- First- Fastest head to head time
- Second- If still tied, fastest time in the division
- Third- If still tied, a tie breaker race (2 of 3 heats)

Racing:

Single Schedule divided among two rings.

Teams will be assigned which ring they are racing in just prior to the end of the race ahead of yours. Please be ready to race at least two races ahead of your race as things can move rather quickly if two rings finish at once. Also, be sure to notify your box loader as to which ring you are in.

Remember- no warm-ups may start until both teams have arrived to race. Check with your judge to be sure.

Line and Box Judge Raffle- Three Drawings per Day:

We will be looking for line and box judge volunteers for each race. Line and Box judges will be given a raffle ticket for each race they judge. We will be giving cash Workers Prizes of \$25.00 each to be drawn 11:00 A.M., 2:00 P.M. and 5:00 P.M. on Saturday and 10:30 A.M., 1:30 P.M. and 3:30 P.M. on Sunday. If you see an empty chair, please jump in and judge. Don't know how to judge? Ask to have someone instruct you and we also have printed instruction sheets available. Clean Break members are not eligible to win. If you see a Clean Break team member judging, ask to take their place.

- Animal Emergency Clinic of York, 1640 S. Queen Street- York, PA, 717-767-5355 will provide 24/7 Vet coverage for the weekend.
- Parking should not be a problem. Please observe all posted signs for parking restrictions. Handicapped Parking is available.
- There will be an on-site food vendor available.
- We will be having a raffle with a silent drawing Sunday afternoon- time to be announced.

Thanks to the many donors and contributors for their generous contributions.

The facility will be open to drop off boxes and set up crating after 5:00 P.M. on Friday, July 30th. All indoor crating areas must have the floor covered with waterproof matting or tarps. This year we are in Memorial Hall East and there is more than enough space for indoor crating. There is also plenty of crating space outdoors if you so desire it.

We are asking teams to bring their own power source if you need to plug in fans, computers, etc., as we will be charged for any extra electrical outlets used, \$25.00 per outlet per day. Our contract with the facility only allows the use of 5 outlets per day before we are charged for additional outlets and we do use those for our displays, computer, etc. needed for racing. If a couple of teams want to go together and share an outlet and split the \$25.00 fee, that's fine. Please see Linda Smith if you want to use electrical outlets. If you have any special circumstances, please let her know.

Friday night we will have Registration for Single Dog Racing starting at 5:00-7:30 with the Racing beginning no later than 5:30 P.M.. We will have one ring available for timed racing and another available for unopposed racing and/or 5 minutes of Practice Time. We will have a box available for use in case your team's box isn't there in time. This is great experience for "green dogs" so don't miss it!

RV/Campers- there is parking for campers on-site overnight for \$26 per day which includes electric & water (no sewer), or \$20 per day if no hook-up is required. Check-in at the office on arrival between 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. on Friday or see the Event Attendant after hours or on Saturday.

Please keep the grass areas clean. Watch your dogs as to where and when they go and clean up after them- bags and containers will be provided.

Unfortunately at Fur Fun's Tournament in June, a theft occurred of a Vendor's Receipts. Please be aware of any spectators who are not Flyball people and let a Clean Break member know if you see anything suspicious.

Please support our vendors at our tournament and be mindful of our surroundings and personal belongings so we will not have anything unfortunate happen at our tournament.
